This report reviews the popularity of Oasis on the music charts and in the music news for the period July to December 2010. It benchmarks Oasis against the 2,987 artists that appeared on the We Are Hunted charts during this period. The results are based on an analysis of 486,631 music articles and 16,063,656 music related tweets. News is sourced from a range of publishers including all the major music news sites and an army of passionate bloggers worldwide. Charts are compiled from samples of hundreds of charts in a range of music genres. This report was written by the We Are Hunted team and generated using the semantic analysis system that powers the [wearehunted.com](#) website.

Chart Popularity

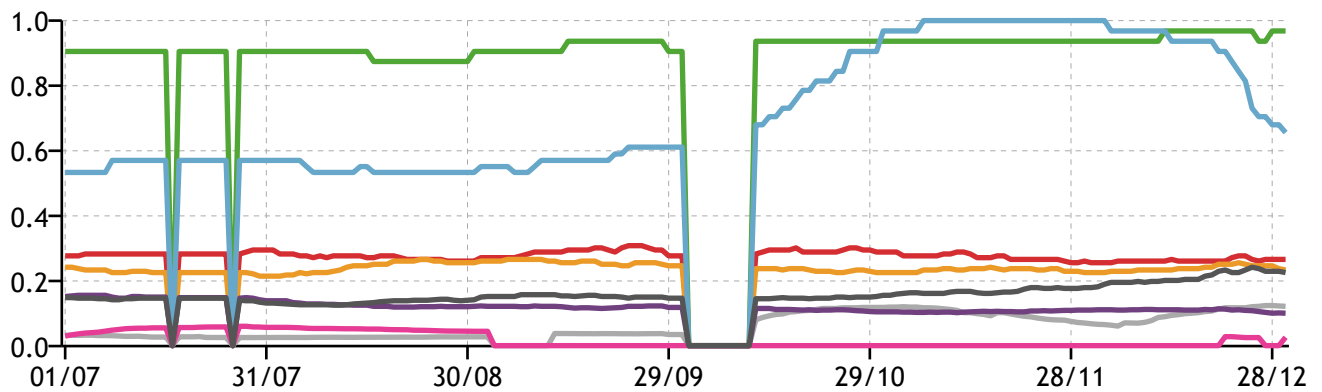


Figure 2: Artist Mainstream Chart Popularity over Time

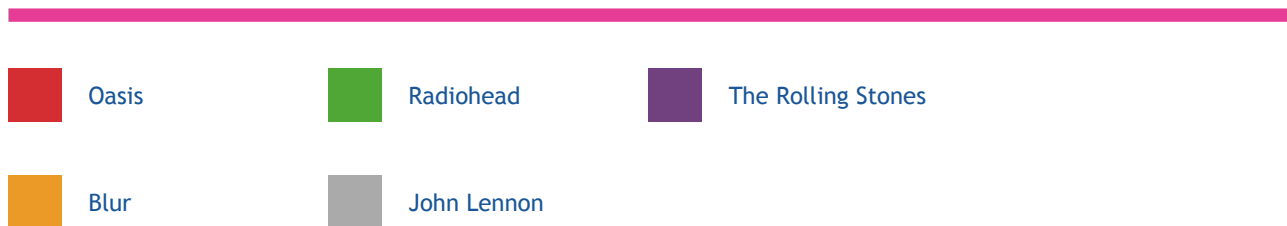

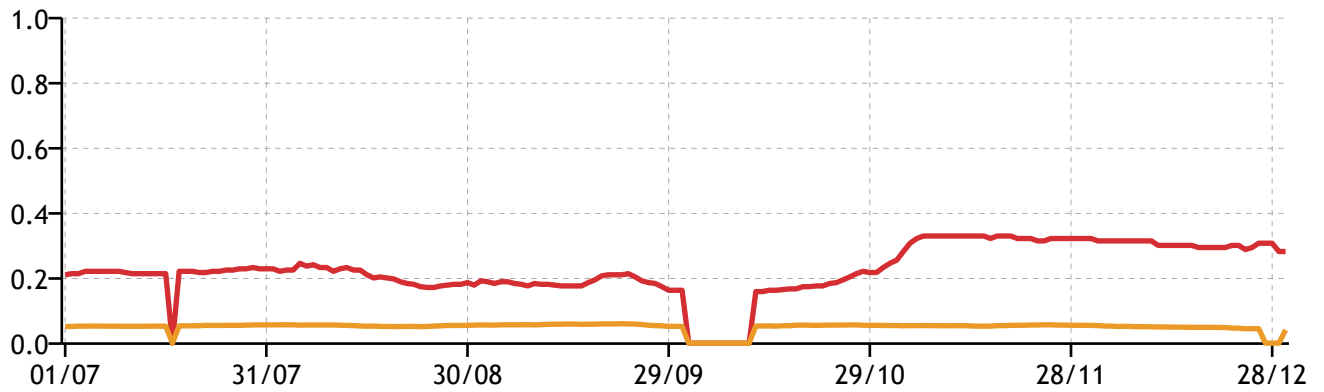


Figure 5: Singles Chart Comparison over Time

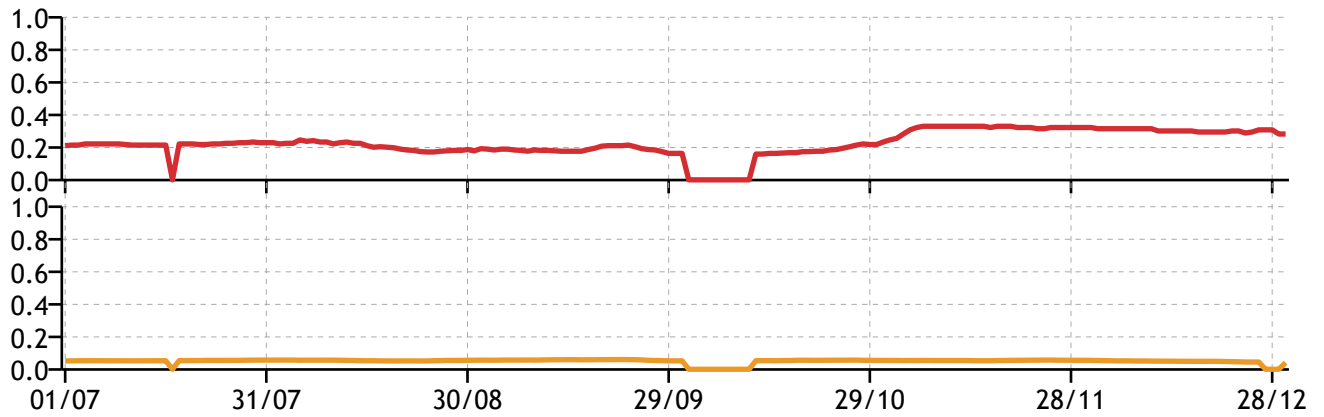


Figure 6: Chart ranking for Oasis

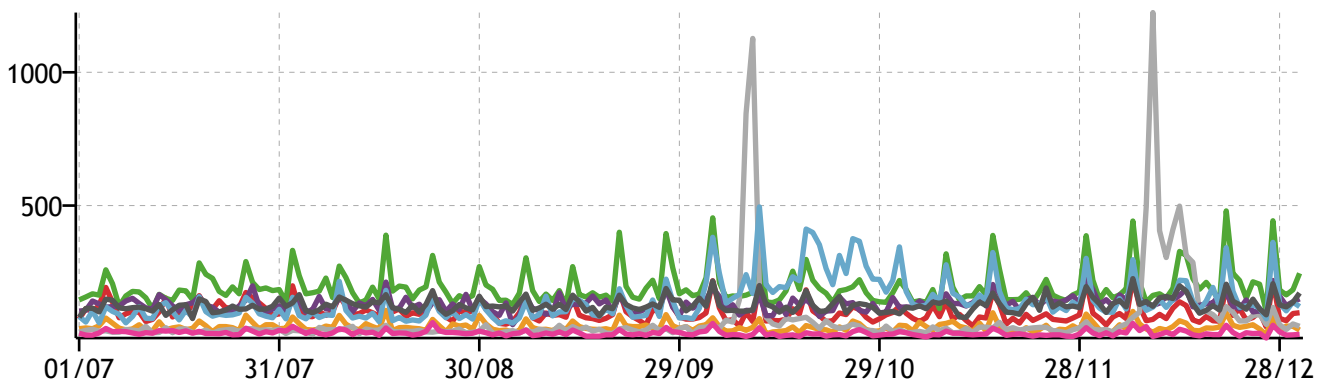


Figure 8: Twitter Coverage over Time

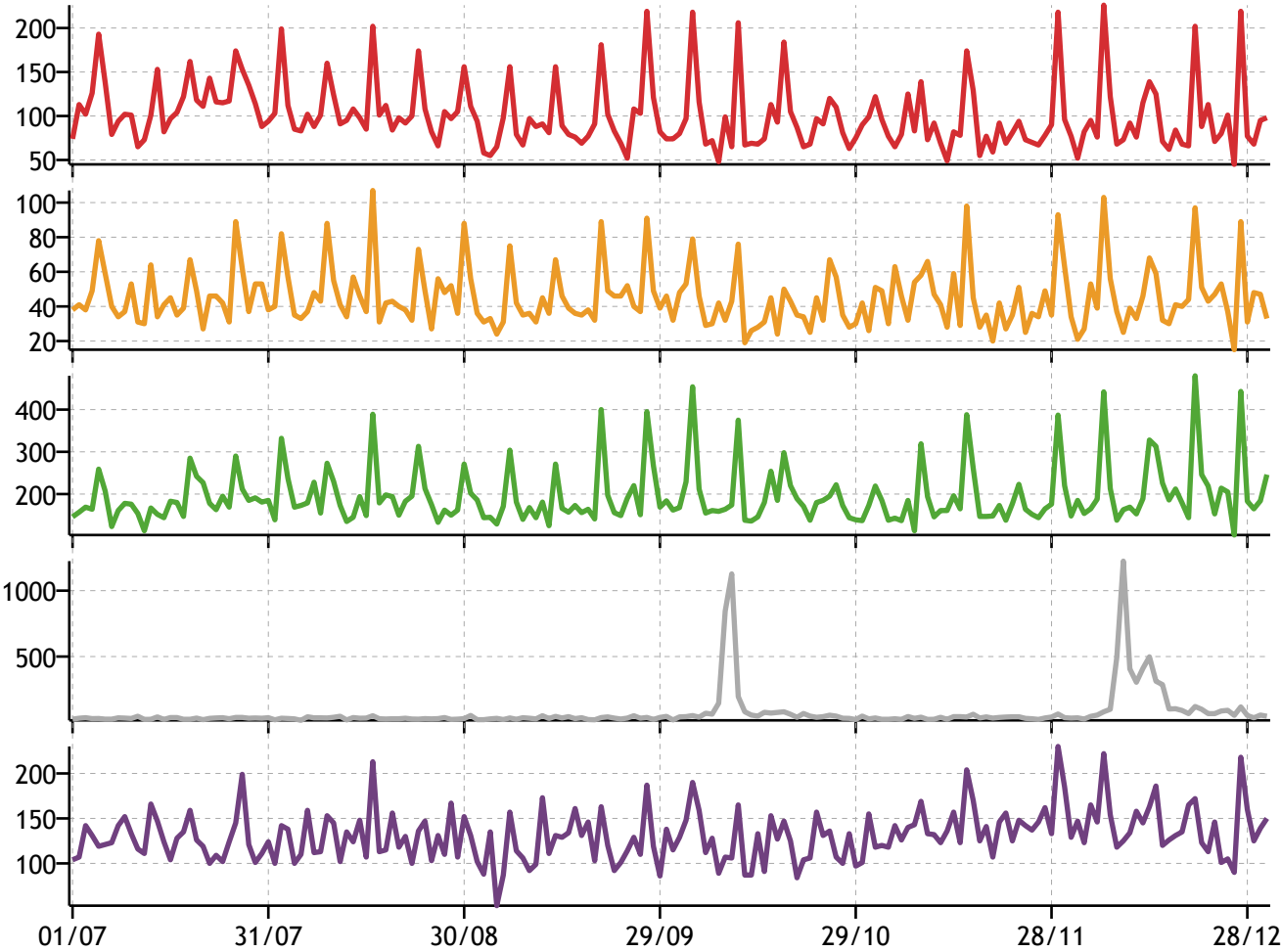
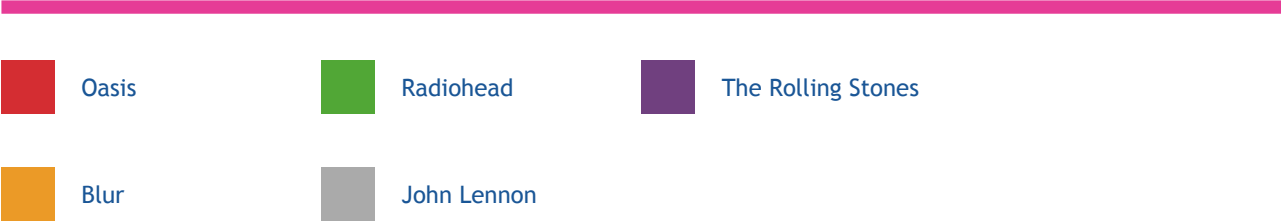


Figure 9: Comparisons for Oasis

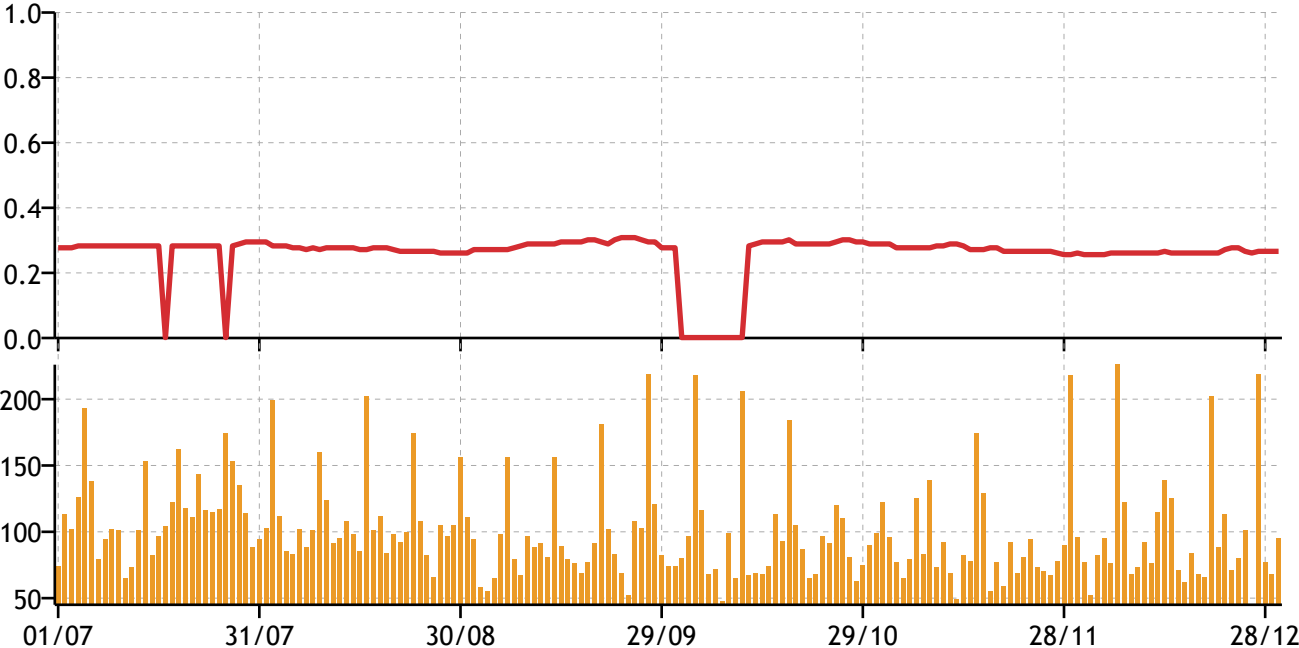


Figure 10: Oasis Chart Popularity vs Twitter Coverage

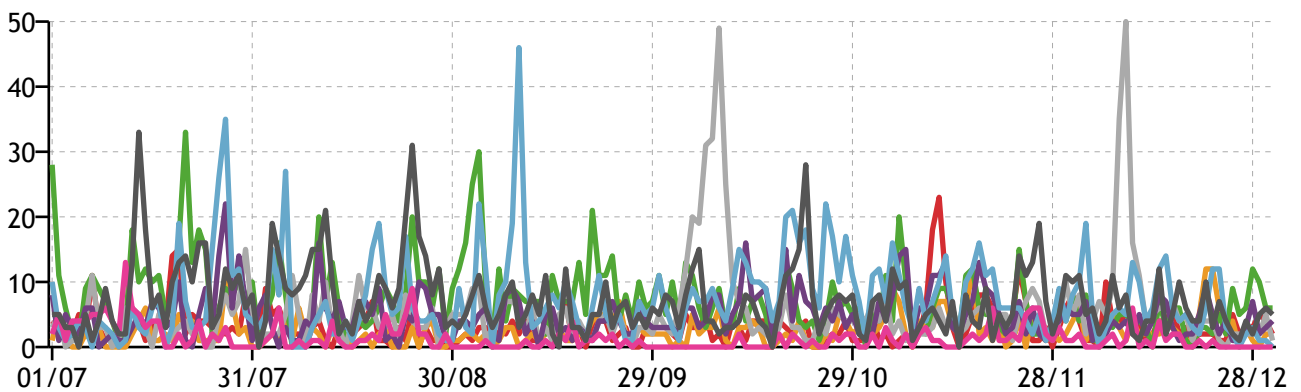


Figure 14: News Coverage over Time

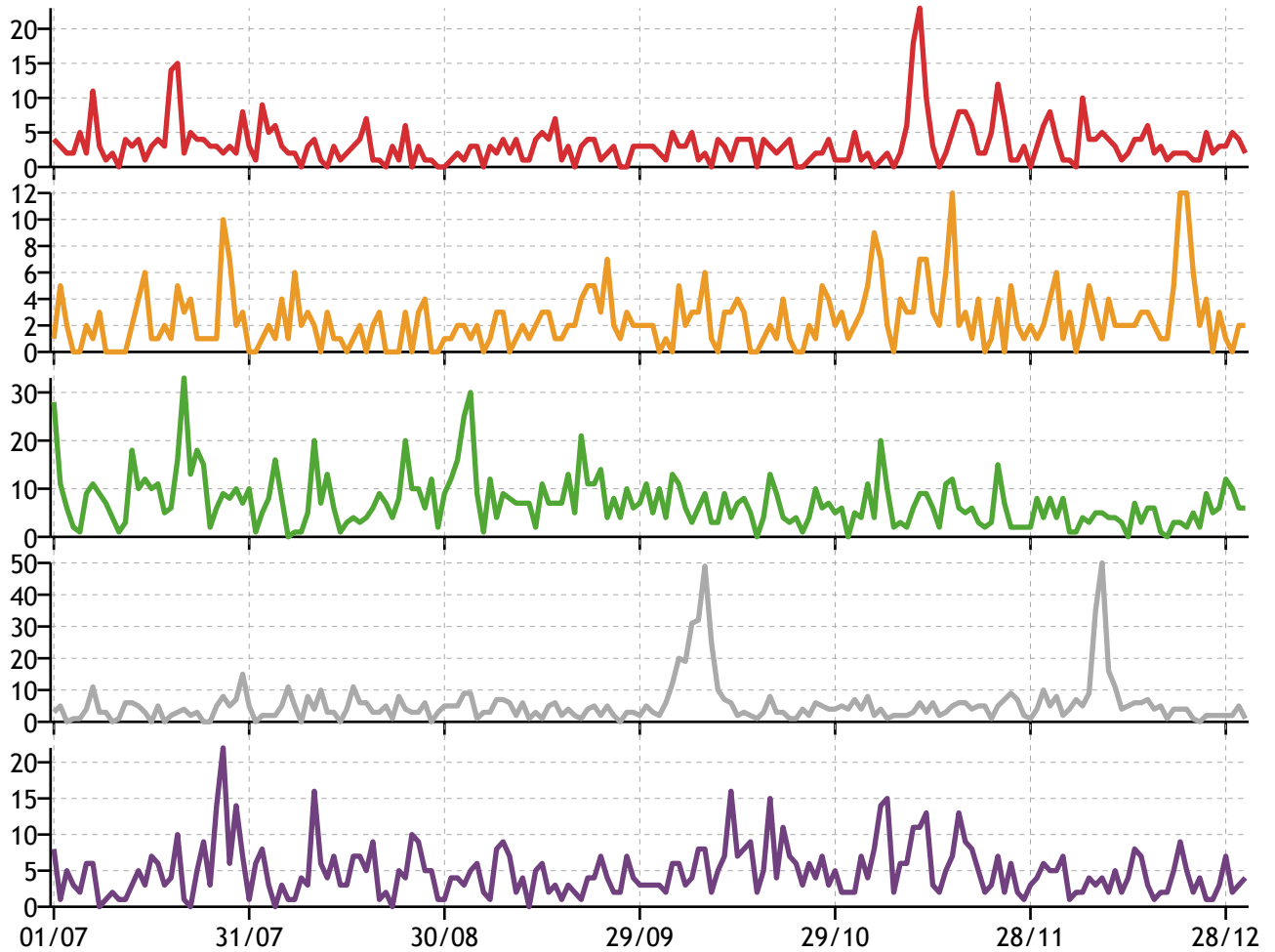
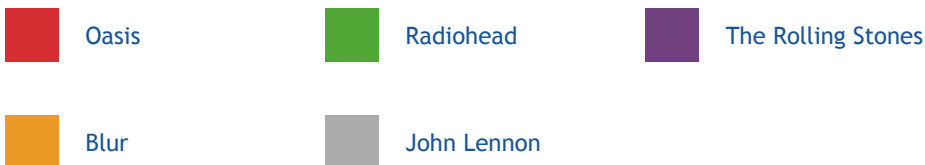


Figure 15: Comparisons for Oasis

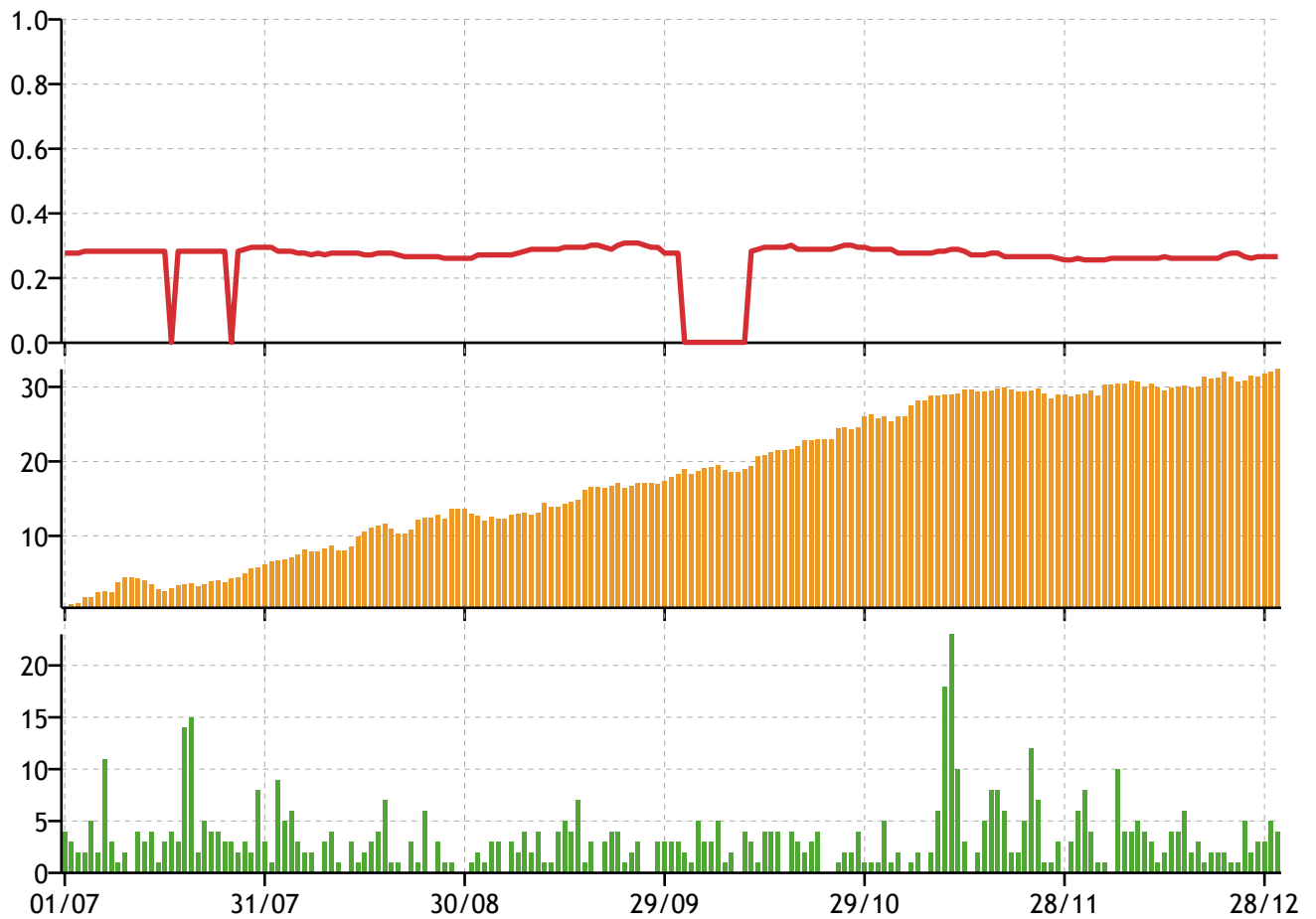


Figure 16: Oasis Chart Popularity vs News Sentiment + Volume
